

## Editorial Policy

Manuscripts should be sent electronically via the journal's editorial system. The author (authors) declare that the manuscript has not been published in another journal or is not considered for publication in another journal. By submitting his manuscript to this magazine, the author/authors accept that the manuscript can be checked for plagiarism. All detected cases of misconduct will be disclosed, including notification to relevant institutions. The editor initially verifies the manuscript and decides to send it for review, send it back for correction or reject it.

All summaries of manuscripts sent to the journal should be written in Polish and English. The magazine does not offer translation services.

The editors send an anonymous version of the manuscript to two (2) experts. After receiving the review, the Editorial Board decides to accept the manuscript, return it to the author (s) for improvement or rejection. The author (authors) receive an anonymous version of the review. When the manuscript is returned to the appropriate author for correction, it must be returned to the Editor within 10 days; otherwise, it may be considered withdrawn.

The manuscript is initially accepted for publication, and the correspondent author receives an email about the need to complete the contract on the transfer of proprietary rights to the Polish Pharmaceutical Society. Each author is required to complete it, scan it, and the correspondent author will send scanned contracts to the editorial system. Then the correspondent author sends the original contract to the Editorial Office. The manuscript will not be published until the original Agreement signed by all authors has been received.

Authors have the right to withdraw the manuscript at any time prior to its publication.

The author (authors) receive by e-mail a PDF file in order to make a copyright correction, which after verification should be sent to the address from which the file was sent, within 3 business days; otherwise, the publication will be withdrawn or published without the author's corrections. Any changes to the manuscript, other than the correction of printing errors, are made under the responsibility of the author. The author (s) may not make any changes to the manuscript that exceed 3% of the volume of the manuscript unless these changes have been consulted with the Publisher. Changes consisting in, inter alia, adding new paragraphs to the text or replacing them with new paragraphs of the existing text are allowed only with the Publisher's consent, provided that these changes do not significantly increase the costs of editing and composition and do not affect the date of publication of the manuscript.

The full version of the manuscript will be available on the journal's website after publication.
